

Keith Rooks Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship was created to honor the life of Keith Rooks and pay tribute to his lifelong work in the field of gymnastics. Keith passed away suddenly in 2015.

Keith led an exemplary life and dedicated much of it to the sport of gymnastics. In 1981, he joined the Attleboro High School boys gymnastics team. He competed in States all four years and by senior year, he was captain of the gymnastics team. He still holds the record on Vault.

Always the performer and sports fan, Keith joined the New England Patriots gymnastics squad in 1984.

Keith received a gymnastics scholarship to Brigham Young University, which he attended from 1985 to 1988. He then transferred to The University of Iowa and competed and as an NCAA gymnast there.

In 1990, Keith made the Bud Light Daredevils acrobatic basketball team. With the Daredevils, he travelled the world, performing at almost every NBA arena as well as hundreds of colleges and special events. Starting in 2005, he directed the NFL mascots at the Pro Bowl in Hawaii.

The Keith Rooks Memorial Scholarship will award three scholarships to deserving seniors.
